SOUNDS LIKE SOME PARTS OF THE AREA HAD SEVERAL INCHES OF SNOW. WE HAD JUST A

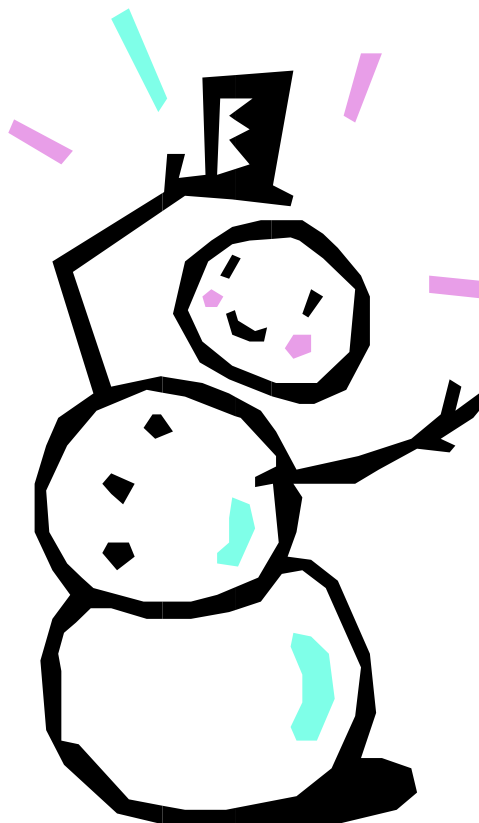
TRACE, BUT THAT IS

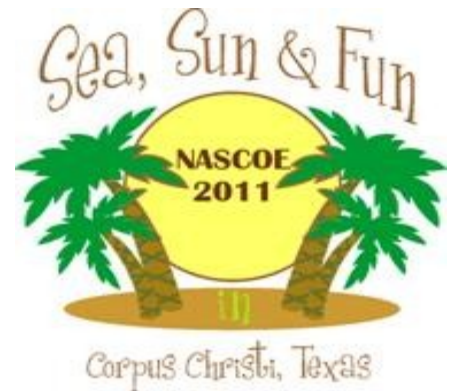
