<u>New deadlines for 2016 NASCOE Scholarship and DSA Awards</u> were announced in December to be January 1, 2016. However due to the late announcement of this new deadline, it was decided to push the deadline back to February 1<sup>st</sup> for the 2016 calendar year. However, it is important to note that the deadline will go back to January 1<sup>st</sup> for 2017 and future year for Scholarships and DSA Awards.

<u>Scholarship Repor</u>t: South Dakota had six NASCOE Scholarship applications for 2016. Four of them were for the NASCOE Traditional Scholarship (\$1500). We also received one application for the NASCOE Open Continuing Education Scholarship (\$1000) and one for the NASCOE Continuing Education for Adult Children Scholarship (\$1000).

All Scholarships were forwarded to Kyra Hagberg, NWA Scholarship Chairperson for judging on February 2, 2016. The NWA judges have until March 20<sup>th</sup> to select the NWA winners and forward them on to the National level for judging. The National winners are to be selected by April 10<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Distinguished Service Award Report</u>: Four 2016 DSA Nominations were received by the February 1, 2016 deadline. There were nominations receive for each DSA Award Category this year. The DSA Awards nominations were sent to the judges who will select a winners. The SD winners will be forward on to the NWA Area Awards Chairperson, Kyra Hagberg by February 20, 2016 for consideration at the NWA level. The NWA selections should be made by March 15<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Years Of Service</u> – Approximately 54 FSA Employees will be recognized for **Years of Service** at this year's State SDASCOE Convention.

<u>Sick Leave Certificates</u> will be presented to SDASCOE members who have reached the 1000, 1500, 2000, 2500 and 3000 hours of sick leave as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015. I will be sending out an email requesting County Offices to submit employee names who have reached these sick leave levels in early March. These Certificates will be presented at the State Convention.

<u>Professional Improvement Award</u> and/or <u>Extra Mile Awards</u> are still available. There is no competition or deadline for these awards. Nomination will be accepted through April 1<sup>st</sup> to be presented at this year's Convention.
